SCIOTO TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES RECORDING OF PROCEEDINGS June 7, 2023

REGULAR MEETING PROCEEDINGS SUMMARY:

The trustees of Scioto Township met in regular session, Wednesday, June 7, 2023 at 7:00pm at the Township Hall, 3737 Ostrander Rd., Ostrander, OH 43061. Board members present were Ralph Moseley, Sandra Stults and Doug Loudenslager. Also present was Fiscal Officer, Kathy Melvin, Chief McIntire, Gary Beckley, Maintenance and Zoning Inspector Herb Ligocki. Others in attendance are included on the sign in sheet.

APPROVAL OF MINUTE

Trustee Loudenslager moved to accept the minutes of the May 17, 2023, as presented by the Fiscal Officer. The motion was seconded by Trustee Moseley. The roll call vote: Ms. Stults-yes, Mr. Moseley-abstain, and Mr. Loudenslager-yes. The motion passed with 2-yes and 1-abstantion vote.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Donna Gibbs resident near Henry demolition project was asking about an update.

Delaware County Engineer - Doug Riedel

- Paving update: schedule comes out every 2 weeks and projects started on the east side of the county.
- The engineer's department is scheduled to move into the Bixby Campus (St. Rt. 521) in August.
- An email was sent to trustees regarding Russell Road North of Penn Road regarding the trees at the curve along with drainage and shoulder information.
 - O Quotes were received but are now 8-9 months old
 - o Quotes for grading and ditch repair were not obtained
 - There is a federal regulation for the township and county to follow regarding 2 endangered bat species.
 - Trees can only be removed from Nov 1 to April 1.
 - Removing the trees would provide a more accurate quote for the shoulder and drainage.
 - The residents will need to be notified and they will want to know what trees are being removed.
 - Ralph Moseley and Doug Riedel will work on the agreement and confirmation of the work needed
 - o Russell Road south of Penn will start in the next 2-4 weeks

- Mitchell Lane and Field Street
 - Only change from the OPWC grant is a swale in the curve which is part of the township.
 - Bids to be out by next Friday and ready to open those bids by July.
 - Targeted to be completed this year.
 - o OPWC application for 2024
 - 4 Roads are reported as poor condition and those are: Fry, Morey, Robinhood Lane, and Tyler. To redo these roads, it would cost \$629,000.
 - Trustee Stults would like to see something done with Robinhood Lane
 - Only 500 ft and not a through road would not make it a good choice for the grant
 - Houseman Rd. is bad and would be close to \$313,000 and a good candidate for the grant
 - o Russell Road north of Penn would be good if the curve was fixed
- Crack Sealing
 - Trustees to send Doug Riedel a list of roads and see if can get them on the schedule
 - Degood, Newhouse and Stults Farm
- Road Mowing
 - o County is trying to get caught up.
 - Have been short on staff
 - Will check schedule and let us know

Delaware County Health Department - Linda Wolcott

- Health Department employees are scattered around the county while their new building is getting completed.
 - o Scheduled move in is first week of July with an open house the next week.

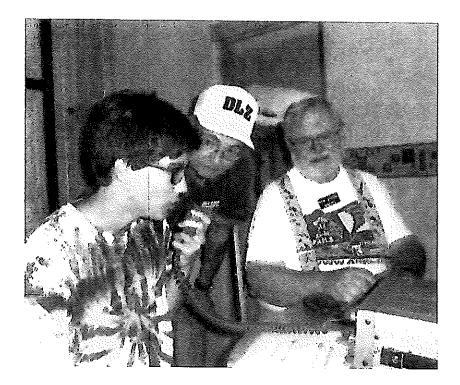
