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**SCIOTO TOWNSHIP TRUSTEES
RECORDING OF PROCEEDINGS
May 21, 2025**

REGULAR MEETING PROCEEDINGS SUMMARY:

The trustees of Scioto Township met in regular session, Wednesday, May 21, 2025, at 5:30 pm at the Township Hall, 3737 Ostrander Rd., Ostrander, OH 43061. Board members present were Ralph Moseley, and Sandra Stults. Fiscal Officer Kathy Melvin and Chief McIntire were present. Doug Loudenslager was absent. Others in attendance are included on the sign in sheet.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Trustee Stults moved to accept the minutes of the May 7, 2025, as presented by the Fiscal Officer. The motion was seconded by Trustee Moseley. The roll call vote: Ms. Stults-yes, Mr. Moseley-yes, and Mr. Loudenslager-absent. The motion passed with 2-yes and 0-no votes.

Doug Riedel from the Delaware County Engineers office was present to discuss the awarding OPWC Small Government Grant project. Scioto was awarded this funding for Calhoun Road. There was an amount for use up to \$435,860.00.

Trustee Moseley made a motion to adopt option 2 to bid this summer with completion of June 2026. The motion was seconded by Trustee Stults. The roll call vote: Ms. Stults-yes, Mr. Moseley-yes, and Mr. Loudenslager-absent. The motion passed with 2-yes and 0-no votes.

Mr. Kent Manley, Thompson Township was present with Mr. Riedel to discuss OPWC grant for Brown Road. Mr. Riedel state this was a worthy project to partner with Thompson Township. Tyler Road could be a good option too. Scioto Township would be the lead for the OPWC Grant and Thompson would be secondary which is reverse of the Brown Road grant application. REA would be needed by the June 4 meeting. Mr. Riedel would not be able to be present for the June 4 meeting. It was suggested to widen both roads if possible.

Trustee Stults made a motion to submit an REA for Tyler Road with Scioto Township being the primary for OPWC grant and a secondary for Brown Road on their OPWC grant. The motion was seconded by Trustee Moseley. The roll call vote: Ms. Stults-yes, Mr. Moseley-yes, and Mr. Loudenslager-absent. The motion passed with 2-yes and 0-no votes.

Mr. Riedel is checking on Larcomb Road and with ODOT to see if they are willing to help with road repairs due to all the excess traffic.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mr. Looney and Mr. Zartman, CEO of ESA, 6455 Houseman Road, Ostrander

- Mr. Dalen Zartman attended the meeting to discuss the business they have on Houseman Road with the Trustees.

- Meet to discuss underlying issues and try and sort out challenges
- Would like to explain the business
 - Global company
 - They respond to national lithium battery challenges
 - 150 employees
 - The testing is done in NY, PA, and AZ NOT in Ohio
 - Facility in Ostrander is research and training lab for service tech, recycling, first responders,
- Lab instruments how to take cars apart and put back together
 - Training is done with props not live
 - Warehousing structure contains supplies to move
 - Evidentiary hold in the fenced in area –
 - No battery testing or burning
- State EPA has been on site for all 4 complaints and went through every door and every container.
- FD will be onsite for EV blanket training on May 27
- They have hosted federal training.

Mr. Looney stated he spoke with Zoning Inspector, Herb Ligocki and Mr. Ligocki was not able to explain the \$150 charge.

Trustee Stults made a motion to pay bills. The motion was seconded by Trustee Moseley. The roll call vote: Ms. Stults-yes, Mr. Moseley-yes, and Mr. Loudenslager-absent. The motion passed with 2-yes and 0-no votes.
